Judas didn't enter the plan of God because he was Satan-possessed and the plan of God goes on in spite of demon-possessed or Satan-possessed individuals; in spite of the opposition of religion; in spite of anyone and anything.

The person who betrayed the Lord demonstrated maximum negative reaction and he never came around to believe in Jesus Christ, accepting Him as his Savior, even though he feels sorry for his sins and even makes restitution for his sins, yet he'll go to the Lake of Fire because he's not trusted Jesus Christ.

The bread is the changeover now from the Passover of the past to the Lord's table of the future.

The cross is going to occur the next day and everything before the cross, we'll call Old Testament; everything after the cross we'll call New Testament.

In the Old Testament, they used the lamb to depict Jesus Christ; from now on, they'll use the bread.

This is the feast of Unleavened Bread and the lamb they ate there, will now be the eating of the bread depicting faith and the blood that was sprinkled, now becomes the cup.

It must be remembered that this is a ritual and this ritual must be meaningful as it solemnly depicts the work of Jesus Christ on the cross.

Every time whenever the Eucharist is observed and the cup is held up, it always represents the blood of Christ; it always represents His death.

Mental attitude is what's in the heart of the believer and the total of all thought impulses that come from the launching pad of a believer's heart is called viewpoint.

Spiritual skills must precede thinking skills for processing biblical truth.

Spiritual skills plus thinking skills cause us to withdraw God's grace-solutions from our spiritual bank account, which is the basis for our spiritual power and the production of divine good in the Christian life.
