“A Worthy Substitute” Part 5

The Bible in its completed form will exist forever and God the Holy Spirit provides the spiritual gift

of pastor-teacher to certain male believers at the point of their salvation and after intense preparation, they are to communicate the content of the Bible to

believer-priests during the Church Age and this gift will not exist after the Church Age.

This communication is to be accomplished in assembly fashion—*Hebrews 10:25.*

As a result of learning biblical truth in the assembly, the Church Age believer becomes spiritually

self-sustaining.

The same power that sustained our Lord before, during and after the cross; the omnipotence of the Holy Spirit is now available to every Church Age believer to sustain us during our Christian walk as members of the Royal Family of God.

The first power option in the Christian life is the filling of the Holy Spirit, a grace gift from Jesus Christ after His resurrection and when this option is consistently used, it becomes a spiritual skill designed by God for us as a major problem-solver in the devil's world.

Accuracy means that we take in biblical truth and live by it, so that our viewpoint in life becomes that of biblical truth.

Just as physical food provides physical energy, biblical truth consumed provides spiritual energy.

Since the moment we believed in Jesus Christ, God has assigned to us a certain amount of time from the very point in which we were saved.

And that time is credited to us so that we can take in God's Word and enjoy all the benefits of a productive spiritual life.

There's a time for peace, a time for war, a time for living and for dying and capacity to enjoy all these things is based on our attitude toward divine truth.

Satan is a profoundly evil being and every bit of good that he does when he masquerades as an angel of light, is just as evil as every bit of sinning he does as the prince of darkness.

Life for believers in Jesus Christ is assigned in terms of days of which God gives us one day at a time

until our allotment runs out.

These days that God gives us are in the devil's world as Satan is the ruler of this world; so these days in time are actually a part of his world system.

And only believers can purchase these days from the evil grip of Satan by using divine funding.

To truly learn something, we have to hear it again and again and again and that's what carves it into our frame of reference where it becomes a programmed file, a part of our conscience or our standards, biblical principles on the launching pad of our soul.

As these truths are communicated again and again, God the Holy Spirit brings them to our remembrance under the authority of the one who teaches them to us.

God is only impressed with the work of God.
