"The Work Of God" John 6:20-29:

Seeing the Lord Jesus walking on water while the disciples held their baskets DID NOT change their mental attitude of fear!

Pressure often makes one concentrate on self; excluding focus on Jesus Christ.

We are only told one time in the Scripture to be legitimately afraid in <u>Hebrews 4:1 NKJV</u>

<u>Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us FEAR lest any of you seem to</u>

have come short of it.

Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My Righteous Right Hand.

Deut 31:6,8; 6 Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. 8 The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.

<u>2Tim 1:7 For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid but gives us power, love and self-discipline.</u>

Ps 56:3 When I am afraid, I put my trust in You.
