John # 110 "This Is A Hard Teaching"

John 6:49-60; 2nd *Corinthians* 4:3-4; *Exodus* 16

It is the primary policy of Satan to discredit God's Good News Gospel.

The Greek word for veiled means to obscure or cloud its meaning and as a part of the prehistoric angelic dispute, Satan is obscuring the Gospel of Jesus Christ because the last thing he wants is a clear presentation of God's gracious saving work heard and understood by anyone.

The passive voice here tells us that Satan has a pre-conceived plan for obscuring the Gospel; he does it through legalism in his subject's lives by way of hypocrisy, mental attitude sins and religion as there are many ways in which a person can be side-tracked as far as God's gracemotivated Gospel is concerned.

Satan must get to unbelievers before they find God somehow, so he's determined that his best option is to blind their minds with falsehoods and pie-in-the-sky schemes which lead to pseudo-happiness.

Satan seeks to cloud their thoughts, blinding them by veiling their thinking with obscurity so when they hear the Gospel, it comes to their souls with outside interference or static which naturally produces a negative reaction resulting in the formation of scar tissue of the soul; the beginning of the process of soul arterial sclerosis known as hardness of heart. *So, there is definite outward opposition to witnessing from Satan who reaches into the thoughts of all unbelievers with his lies.*

<u>Like it or not, we are all Christian soldiers and some of us are in basic training, others in</u> <u>AIT, Advanced Individual Training and others have graduated bootcamp and specialized</u> <u>training and are out in the field of battle and so, how do we handle that?</u>

Jas 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 2^{nd} Thess 3:3 But the Lord is faithful and He will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

Eph 6:10-11 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

For men to think that they can facilitate or negotiate world peace now; something only the Lord Jesus can accomplish in the Millennium, is incredibly arrogant as it shows complete disregard for what the Bible teaches.

War is inevitable as Jesus Christ Himself declared.

Only when our Lord returns at His Second Advent will He establish world peace.

So, until our Lord's return, nations will continue to do battle in this world and what peace we do have, however widespread or lengthy, will be the result of a strong, highly prepared military force in place. Believers cannot cram biblical truth and say things like "I graduated from Bible school 10 years ago, so I'm all set."

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<u>1st Cor 2:5 "...so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom but on God's power."</u> <u>2nd Cor 5:7 "For we live by faith, not by sight."</u>

<u>Manna spoiled if it was kept overnight, yet it was preserved for hundreds of years.</u> Thank God that the failure of the Exodus generation did not disallow us from an opportunity to succeed!

Manna melted but it didn't melt; Exodus 16:21

Only that manna which was brought inside was preserved and used for nourishment. This represents biblical truth in the soul of the believer.

We cannot apply what we do not know.
