## "A Man Of Truth"

John 7:16-18; Luke 22:47-53, 63-65; Luke 23:8-12; Matthew 26:62-68; John14:1-11

In the Church Age, we have spiritual mechanics graciously provided by God which offer the potential for us to develop spiritual skills to run our spiritual life on all cylinders.

Mechanics is a science that deals with the action of forces in motion; it's the science of how moving parts of a system perform a complete function of motion to fulfill an intended objective and a skill is the ability to do something well as a result of learning, applying and accurate repeated practicing of such mechanics.
