**“Equal Privilege plus
Equal Opportunity equals
Inequality” Part 2**

Romans 3:29-31

Proverbs 2:10-17

Satan gets believers occupied with temporal solutions to man’s problems leading to neglect of divine solutions.

God in His sovereignty is pleased to give angels and man free-will.

Man is made in the “image of God” (who has free-will) and that indicates the existence of human free-will.

Man’s free-will first meets the sovereign will of God at the cross.

Suffering related to self obviously follows the policy of wrong thinking, wrong motives, wrong decisions and wrong actions in life.

Most wrong decisions reflect disregard or negative attitude toward biblical truth, as mentioned in *Proverbs 1* and *8*.

Under the law of divine punitive action, God disciplines us to remove guilt from us.

Recovery in *1 John 1:9*, is the divine solution for the removal of guilt from the soul.

There is no emphasis on how we feel or promising God we will do better stated or implied in *1 John 1:9*.

Without God’s recovery technique as the protection of the soul, the believer becomes a slave to the emotional sins, especially guilt.

Everyone must take the responsibility for his own decisions and his own actions in life. Free-will and decisions are the source of sins of ignorance and cognizance; so, each of us must be held responsible for our own decisions, whether we understand them or their consequences.

There is intense suffering from violating the sacredness of life, property and privacy in criminal acts.

If I am suffering from my wrong decisions, no prayer in the world can help me, I must go to the solutions found in the Word.

Man manufactures his own problems and suffering; God manufactures solutions and blessings in the midst of suffering.

So, by wrong thinking and wrong motivation, we enter into self-imposed misery long before we make decisions that cause self-induced misery.

Interaction with people is always going to fail unless we have personal love for God the Father, impersonal love for all people and occupation with Jesus Christ.

The more of the Word of God you master, the more conclusions you can draw and the greater should be your humility.

Spiritual self-esteem plus biblical confidence promote personal love for God the Father and impersonal love for all mankind.
