Salvation is what God does for us and not what we do for God.

Spirituality is what God does for us and not what we do for God.

Our entire Christian life is what God does for us and not what we do for God.

When we understand God’s integrity,

we develop an awe and respect for Him and eventually, with enough of His Word, we’ll have real personal love for Him.

David indicates human good is not included in the plan of God, because God is so great that He does not rely on anything we can do.

One of the greatest exhibitions of the crafty nature of Satan is the promotion of his doctrine through the social gospel, world peace, internationalism and socialism; doing good in the name of good.

Satan would love to abolish war and get the credit for it.

God is perfectly just in

His condemnation of all nonreligious and religious people.

If you’re going to escape God’s wrath, you must place your faith in Jesus Christ to save you from your sins.

The Jew has a great advantage in being able to see that he cannot measure up to the righteousness of God because he has the entire Old Testament which clearly testifies of his guilty condition before Him.

Many people ask the wrong question: How can a loving God send His creatures to Hell?

The right question is:

How can a righteous God permit any sinful human to enter His Heaven?

Nothing is more important than knowing what God thinks and understanding how He operates through His integrity.

Grace is the genius plan of God to bless us; integrity is the character of God and His Word is the revelation of His genius and character!

ALL praise and worship MUST be related to the integrity of God.

Praise is blasphemous meaningless flattery without genuine motivation.

When the Bible says God loves us, it means He loves His righteousness in us which He gave us when we believed in His only Son.

God is impressed with God and pleased those that recognize who He is by expressing faith alone in Christ alone and spending their entire existence diligently seeking Him.

God loves His integrity much more than He loves us!

God cannot have the same love for you that He has for His perfect righteousness, but when we have His righteousness in us, He cannot love that righteousness in us any less than He loves it in Himself!

Love is not a problem solver, virtue or integrity is.

Love is not a solver of problems, love is for those who’ve solved their problems.

Infinite perfect God cannot love us,
He can only condemn us, unless
His integrity remedies our condition.

We have to be mature believers before we can sign ‘Oh how I love Jesus’
and mean it!

We will never understand our salvation, if we don't understand divine integrity.
Once you understand the integrity of God, you have enough truth to praise Him.
