**“The Gospel of God”**

***Rms1:1-2;***

**When you’ve mastered the book of *Romans*, you can think like Jesus Christ without a Bible to reference.**

**At the heart of Paul's argument is Jesus Christ our Lord and the theme of the epistle is adjustment to the justice of God, leading to union with Christ.**

**The Lord Jesus is paramount in all of Paul's thinking, as it is in God's program for mankind everywhere.**

**Then the final outcome, which begins with the Lord Himself and flows through the apostle to the Christians, is that the Gospel reaches the nations of the world; Jew and Gentile alike. Paul serves Christ in the power with which Christ serves Paul.**

***Romans 1:2* is not only a statement about the content of God’s Gospel, but it’s also a reason for believing it.**

**God promised in the Scriptures, so it’s God speaking in them and that’s what makes them holy.**

**When we add anything to faith in Christ for salvation, it’s by works which is not salvation at all.**

**Rationalism says that reality is what one thinks to be true.**

**Perception by faith is always non-meritorious, because it depends on the authority, confidence and ability of someone else.**

**As we begin to grow spiritually under post-salvation biblical rehabilitation, we form rationales, like the Essence of God Rationale, the Logistical Grace Rationale and the A Fortiori Rationale.**

**Remember that logistical grace is for winners and losers.**

**Fear, worry, anxiety or apprehension is rejection or ignorance of God’s logistical grace provision, yet God continues to support even those who worry.**

**Grace gives you the ability to live one day at a time, not handicapped by the past and not distracted by the future.**

**A fortiori is a system of argumentation or debate which takes an accepted fact and by comparison produces an inescapable fact and confident conclusion.**

**In life, every time you apply the Word of God in your soul to a situation, there is a decoration for you in Heaven.**

**Jews in the OT were saved because they believed in Jesus Christ and today Gentiles are saved through exactly the same faith.**

**Either excluding faith in Christ or adding to faith in Christ becomes a system of blasphemy known as salvation by works.**

**Until the Jewish people have faith in Christ, their expression is ritual without reality, worship without truth, one of the greatest disasters of all history.**

**This emphasizes that the prophets were here on the earth for the primary purpose of serving the Lord and not their own desires, interests or agendas.**

**We must come to a point in our spiritual growth where we learn that we have a new Master.**
